Our wines consist of a very high quality, whilst maintaining competitive prices.

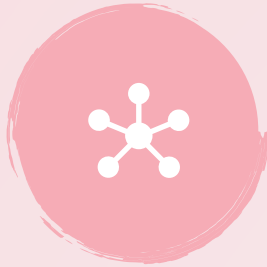


About Us

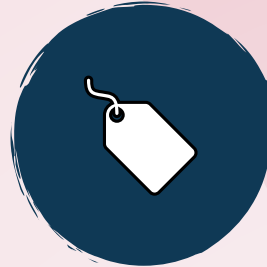
Production Formats

Lismore Wines produces and sells its wine in 3 main formats



Bulk Exports

We typically export several million litres pa of bulk NZ wine, predominantly in 24,000L flexi-tanks, but also in 26,000L ISO tanks.



Private Label Bottled

We provide an end-to-end service (wine sourcing, packaging/ bottling and shipping) for offshore clients who want their labels on wine bottled at source, in New Zealand.

For many years we have successfully supplied grocery chains with large volumes of their private labelled product in the UK, USA, Australia, Europe and Asia.

Lismore Wines can also offer private label bottling of our wines in Australia and Belgium.



Own Brand Bottled

Lismore Wines has 4 of our own labels that we bottle various wine varieties in. We are happy to sell wine under these labels to customers who want them or do not have suitable labels of their own. We are also happy to work together with customers in co-developing new label designs.

As well as bottling its wines in New Zealand, Lismore Wines now **also bottles at a facility in Antwerp** – making supply and collection that much easier (and more affordable) for our European customers.

- We grow Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris and Chardonnay grapes **in our own Hawkes Bay vineyards.**
- Our network of supply partners means that we also produce other core varieties from New Zealand's primary wine-growing regions.

These include Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir from regions like Nelson, North Canterbury and Central Otago.

- Other varieties are available on request.

Wine Varieties

We specialise in producing Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc and Pinot Noir, as well as Hawkes Bay Sauvignon Blanc, Pinot Gris and Chardonnay.

Widely regarded as one of New Zealand's leading winemakers, Alan McCorkindale has four decades of winemaking experience.

Graduated from Roseworthy Agricultural College as dux and winner of the Leo Buring medal in 1983.

Winemaking experience in Burgundy, Champagne, Alsace, Rheingau, Hunter Valley and Tasmania, winemaking in Marlborough since 1988.

Wines have won many gold medal awards and trophies including 'International White Wine of the Year', twice at the London International Wine Challenge

Being their first vintage, the 2024 wines have been receiving rave reviews and have quickly developed a cult following. With a Gisborne blend, Single Vineyard offering and a Wild Ferment blend available there's something for everyone!

Tasting Notes

- This classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc carries a pale straw colour. Aromas of lifted citrus, tropical fruit and crushed herbs add to a fresh, juicy wine with vibrant acidity and plenty of weight and length on the palate. Ripe, tropical fruit, with passionfruit, melon and grapefruit flavours abound. A wine to be enjoyed during the next 12 to 18 months and it may develop further complexity with extended cellaring.
- An ideal match with roast poultry, seafood or to be enjoyed simply on its own as an aperitif.

Tasting Notes

- Fresh blackberry and raspberry aromas are underlined by toasted oak notes in this beautifully ripe Pinot Noir from New Zealand's sunny wine capital, Marlborough. Regular, gentle plunging of the must extracted colour and tannin, adding to the seductive savoury underlay reminiscent of wood spice. The fruit flavours linger on the medium-bodied palate in this, dry-finishing wine.
- Pairs excellently with red meat and Asian-inspired dishes.
